#### Dear Parents/Carers

This week Nursery & Reception children went on a walk in our local area as part of their learning in Geography and they even had a go at drawing maps when they returned! They also got involved in a litter pick, helping them to understand the importance of looking after our community.

Class 10 visited The Oaks today for a Design & Technology 'Wheels' day where they had the opportunity to design and create their own vehicle and had a fabulous time using The Oaks' specialist DT equipment.

Earlier in the week, Year 5 were exploring Robin Wood and all that it has to offer, ready for their residential visit at the start of Year 6.

Educational visits are an important part of the curriculum here at Gainsborough. We aim to take learning outside of the classroom as often as possible and all classes take part in at least one off site visit every half term. We try to keep the cost to parents to a minimum by having at least half of our visits in the local community and free of charge. Despite rising coach company costs (the average visit costing £600 for just the coach), we are careful to keep costs down for visits further afield.

Educational visits are important because they -

- Form an important part of our curriculum with cross curricular links to different subjects.
- Help to enrich the curriculum.
- Boost self-esteem and motivation.
- Develop and enhance social skills.
- Promote health, fitness, fun and enjoyment.
- Help to build stronger links between schools and communities.
- Broaden a child's horizons and their knowledge of the world around them.
