

## Gainsborough Primary & Nursery School Newsletter



I thought I would take this opportunity to remind you about our work here at Gainsborough as a 'No Outsiders' school.

Our curriculum helps our children to understand and celebrate diversity. We create an atmosphere that is caring, happy and inclusive and which celebrates the unique differences of all the children in our school. Put simply, 'All Different, All Welcome'.

No Outsiders is a proactive approach which encourages the children to value each other. Through weekly assemblies, daily discussions around a picture and half termly exploration of a theme in a story book, it challenges stereotypes and the use of derogatory language.



'No Outsiders', alongside other elements of our SRE (Sex and Relationships Education) and PSHE (Personal, Social & Health Education) curriculum aims to ensure that Gainsborough is a place where every member of the school community feels welcome.

Please remember to send in your child's book bag and reading diary every day. Make sure you read at home 4 times or more for a reward on Monday.







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
