## A brief history

The Computer Misuse Act 1990 was introduced into UK Law after two hackers obtained, without the persons knowledge, the username and password of an I.T. engineer who worked for a large telephone communications company.

The two hackers then remotely logged into the I.T. engineers' account and to their surprise they were able to access the mailbox of Prince Phillip! The police were notified and the hackers were arrested. The two hackers were convicted under the Forgery and Counterfeiting Act 1981. The hackers claimed that their actions were not for financial gain, but they had simply wanted to demonstrate that they could hack the system.

On appeal, their convictions were overturned as it could not be said that they had committed forgery under the legislation. The Computer Misuse Act 1990 was created to deal with the issue of accessing or modifying data without permission.
