Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back to the new school year and an especially big welcome to all those families new to Gainsborough. The children have all had a successful week and we are proud of how quickly they have settled in to the routines and expectations of their new classes.

We hope that you enjoyed the opportunity to meet the new year group staff teams during our 'Meet the Teacher' drop in yesterday.

Today your child will have brought home a curriculum brochure which outlines all of their learning for this term. A copy can also be found on the school website on each of the year group pages.

At this time of year we like to remind parents/carers about our expectations for attendance. We know that days off school soon add up, and children who have high attendance rates make better progress in their learning.

It is therefore important to keep your child's absences to a minimum. If your child is absent, you must **notify the school on each, and every day of absence by phone**, (01270 696810) or in person.

Parents/carers should be aware that the Local Authority may issue a Fixed Penalty Notice if a child has 10 or more unauthorised absences in any one term. The Penalty Notice is issued individually to each parent/carer who fails to ensure their child's regular attendance at school. The Penalty is £60 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days rising to £120 if paid within 28 days.

Please be aware that school cannot authorise any leave of absence during term time for a holiday or other visits abroad to visit family. Again, absences could result in a Fixed Penalty Notice.

RAAC (Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete)
