During their guided tour, they noticed the black smoke marks that still remain on the sandstone walls of Saint Mary's church . They also spotted the place where the Bear Inn was located in 1583. Furthermore they saw the pillory where Nicholas Brown was punished for causing the fire and a plaque that was carved as a tribute to Queen Elizabeth in gratitude of her £1000 donation for the rebuild on Nantwich.
