
Our Curriculum

Educational Visits and Experiences

At **Gainsborough**, we pride ourselves on delivering high quality educational visits that are fully risk assessed with reference to specific activities and individual cohorts. Every planned educational visit and visitor will directly link to the theme/topic that the children are learning about.

We make the most of our local area with visits to Queens park, Crewe library and whole school visits to All Saints church. Further afield, educational visits include Beeston Castle, Chester Zoo and Delamere Forest.

Residentials

Children in year 4 and 6 also have the opportunity to take part in a residential visit.

In year 4 the children spend one night away. They take part in instructor led activities which focus on team building and adventurous activities such as climbing, obstacle course and bushcraft.

In year 6 the children spend two nights away. They experience an exciting range of instructor led activities including zip wire, crate challenge and the piranha pool.

Both of these residentials encourage the children to make life long memories and helps to forge strong friendships as well as gaining valuable skills and confidence.



After School Clubs

Some teachers and teaching assistants run a variety of after school clubs each half term for our children to enjoy. They change every half term and can include Lego, basketball, drawing, gymnastics, choir and board games.

Music Tuition

From year 2 the children can have instrumental lessons during the school day. We have several different organisations that come into school to deliver these lessons. We have tutors that teach piano, violin, ukulele, guitar and can also teach other woodwind or brass instruments.





Pastoral Care

Mrs Graham is our Pastoral Manager. Mrs Graham works in partnership with parents and carers, along with a variety of other external agencies and services, to ensure the wellbeing and the safeguarding of pupils at Gainsborough.

If you would like any help, support or advice from our School Pastoral Manager, contact the school directly via telephone or email or you could stop for a chat at the school gate where you will find Mrs Graham before and after school.

Staff can identify when pupils are showing signs of distress and when there is a change in their mood. They have a clear understanding of the procedures they must follow if they are concerned about a pupil's welfare. Inclusion

Gainsborough Primary and Nursery Academy is an inclusive school that aims to provide a caring, supportive and accessible environment in which all pupils are valued equally and are given the opportunity to develop their full potential. We provide a nurturing environment and aim to fully include children with special educational needs and/or disabilities in all aspects of school life. Within our school, there is a wide range of expertise, strategies and resources that enable staff to embrace our inclusive ethos. This includes provision for children with social and emotional needs, as well as academic needs.

The SEND team are available to talk to you if you feel that your child has any additional needs. They will work with you, the class teacher and your child and, where it is felt to be of benefit, they will approach outside agencies for further advice and support. Our aim is to work co-operatively to the benefit of each child.

Leaders quickly identify the needs of pupils with SEND, including for those children in the early years. Teachers adapt how they deliver curriculums through additional support and resources. Uniform


At Gainsborough we believe that having a school uniform can make life easier for children as they are not under unnecessary pressure to wear the most expensive labels or the latest fashion.
